
KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

WESTBOUND LANE CLOSURE FROM HONOMANU STREET TO KAONOHI STREET

Estimated Duration: November 2019 to end of March 2020

Nights from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Hitachi Rail Honolulu, on behalf of the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART), will temporarily close the westbound left lane on Kamehameha Highway from Honomanu Street to Kaonohi Street for overhead construction. No left turns will be permitted through the Kaonohi Street intersection. Motorists will be detoured to Pali Momi Street or Kanuku Street, as illustrated in the image above.

The closure is anticipated to start November and will take place, nights between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Business access will be maintained. Traffic control measures and detour signs will be posted. Please observe signs and posted speed limits in construction zones.

These closures are needed for the safety of the public and our crews as overhead construction continues. Mahalo for your patience, understanding and cooperation.

TRAFFIC SAFETY



It is everyone's kuleana (responsibility) to be mindful of changing roadway conditions in construction zones. **A few minutes of patience and alertness on the road can save a life.** Below are a few helpful tips for your morning and afternoon commutes.

PLAN AHEAD

Lane reductions and turn restrictions may impact your commute. Allow extra time through the construction zone, especially during school drop-off and pick-up times.

EYES FORWARD

Road conditions may change around a work area. Minimize distractions and stay alert for construction workers, vehicles or pedestrians.

SLOW MEANS SAFE

Follow posted speed limits while traveling within construction zones. Construction zone speed limits have been lowered to 25 miles per hour.
